

THE NATIONAL BUILDING REGULATIONS AND BUILDING STANDARDS ACT NO. 103 OF 1977, SECTION F6 (2)(A) DICTATES THAT:

"No person shall during the course of any building, demolition or excavation work use any machine, machinery, engine, apparatus, tool or contrivance, which in the opinion of the local authority may unreasonably disturb or interfere with the amenity of the neighbourhood:

- (i) on a public holiday or Sunday
- (ii) before 06:00 or after 17:00 on any Saturday; and
- (iii) before 06:00 or after 18:00 on any day other than those days contemplated in subparagraphs (i) and (ii)"

In other words, NO NOISY BUILDING WORKS ON SUNDAYS OR PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.
