NATIONAL LEVEL:

Challenge: National needs to declare the issue an Ecological Crisis in order to prioritize and unlock funding and research. PNRA Action: Support the organizations lobbying for change.

PROVINCIAL / LOCAL GOVERNMENT LEVEL:

Challenge: City Parks do not yet have an Operational Plan. Challenge: City Parks to improve their communications. Challenge: City Parks needs to secure FUNDING for R&D,

wood chippers, equipment, training, new trees, etc.

Challenge: City Parks & Pikitup need to prioritize a solution

for responsible disposal of infested timber. PNRA Action: To lobby and agitate for change.

the issue and to find government funding.




